

SAVE THE DATE

Artwork Drop Off: There is a protocol for artwork drop-off. Artists can sign up online at DareArts.org/molliefearingshow for a specific day and time to drop off their artwork. Work must be hand-delivered by appointment to Dare Arts, 300 Queen Elizabeth Avenue in Manteo, between 10am & 4pm Thursday, April 25, Friday, April 26 or Saturday, April 27. You will be expected to pay the entry fee by at the time of drop off. A completed identification label (included on the last page of this prospectus) should be attached to the work.

Opening Reception & Show Dates: Join us for the opening reception Sunday, May 5 from 2pm - 4pm at the Dare Arts Gallery. The show will remain open during normal gallery hours from Tuesday, May 7 through Saturday, June 1.

Artwork Pick-Up Date: Tuesday, June 4 from 10pm to 5pm.

Please make arrangements for pick-up on that day. Unless prior arrangements have been made, artwork remaining after pick-up will be considered a donation to Dare Arts. Artists may not remove entries before this designated time.

GUIDELINES

Entry Fees:

Open to Dare Arts members and nonmembers. Member entry fee is \$25 and nonmember entry fee is \$35. Works by artists under the age of 18 are subject to Dare Arts Program Committee approval.

Submitted Works:

Each artist may submit one entry in any visual arts media. Entries must be original, executed within the last two years (without supervision), and not previously entered in any Dare Arts exhibit.

All works must be presentation-ready. Paint must be dry. Frameable pieces must be framed (unless having no frame is essential to the piece). Necessary hardware must be attached to hanging pieces—no sawtooth hangers. Bases must be attached and/or displays included.

All work must be signed by the artist.

Two-dimensional pieces must not exceed sixty inches in height or width (including frame). Three-dimensional pieces may not exceed six feet in height (including base) or six feet in diameter. For work requiring special installation or care, please contact DareArtsShows@gmail.com before submission.

All artwork must be for sale. Selling price should include a 40% commission retained by Dare Arts. Artist payments will be mailed by the 15th of June. Dare Arts reserves the right to photograph the entries for publicity purposes. Dare Arts reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Liability & Sales:

While the best possible care will be exercised in the handling of works, neither the Gallery, their employees and volunteers, nor the sponsoring agencies shall be held responsible for loss or damage from fire, theft, vandalism, or any other cause. Submission of artwork shall imply an agreement by the artist to the conditions set forth in the prospectus.

OUR JUDGE

Patrick Berran is an artist that lives and works in Kill Devil Hills, NC. He received his BFA at Virginia Commonwealth University, Richmond, VA and his MFA from Hunter College, New York, NY. Patrick's work is abstract in nature, utilizing collage in his paintings and works on paper. Patrick has exhibited his work both nationally and internationally, recent solo exhibitions include Chapter NY, NY, White Columns, NY, COA Arts Gallery, Manteo, NC, Hunter Whitfield, London UK, and Reynolds Gallery in Richmond, VA. Recent group exhibitions include The American Academy of Arts and Letters New York, NY, Southampton Art Center, the Hall Art Foundation in Reading, VT, Rod Bianco, Oslo; M+B Gallery, Los Angeles; Indianapolis Museum of Contemporary Art, Indianapolis; and Gavin Brown's Enterprise, New York. Patrick has been a visiting artist and guest lecturer at Alfred University, Kent State University and Virginia Commonwealth University. He has completed artist residencies at the Constance Saltonstall Foundation for the Arts in Ithaca, NY, Dial House in Essex, UK, Vermont Studio Center, and the Virginia Center for the Creative Arts in Amherst, VA. His work has been reviewed in the New York Times, Hyperallergic, the Brooklyn Rail and his work has been featured in Bomb Magazine and Architectural Digest. Patrick is a full-time faculty member within the Humanities & Fine Arts Department at the College of the Albemarle.



The Mollie Fearing Memorial Art Show is held annually in memory of Mollie Fearing, one of the founding members of Dare Arts.

In 1975, a group of citizens gathering at Mollie's house began what was originally called the Sea and Sounds Arts Council. It was established to bring cultural arts programming to Dare County, including dance, theater, visual arts, music, literature and more.

More than 45 years later, her vision, and that of our founders, remains strong in our organization.

Mollie was a vital supporter and advocate of the arts until she passed away on September 3, 1997. We are pleased to celebrate her memory and remember her many contributions to our area through this annual exhibit.
