ABOUT THE SHOW

Artists will have a unique chance to combine their creative talents with local history this Spring as part of a joint venture between Dare Arts and the Chicamacomico Life-Saving Station for the 150th Anniversary of the U.S. Life-Saving Service in North Carolina.

Artists have the opportunity to take original shakes from the 1911 Chicamacomico Cookhouse and transform them into works of art. All shakes will be for sale at the exhibit for \$150, and all proceeds will be split between Dare Arts and the Chicamacomico Historical Association to further their missions' work in the community.

SAVE THE DATES

Shake Pick Up: Artists who would like to participate in this historical arts project can pick up a shake (or shakes!) at Dare Arts in Manteo, Black Pelican Restaurant in Kitty Hawk, the Chicamacomico Life-Saving Station in Rodanthe, or Buxton Village Books in Buxton. You can also contact Dare Arts for delivery between Manteo and Kitty Hawk.

Artwork Drop Off: Artists are asked to drop off their finished shake(s) to Dare Arts or any of the above locations no later than Friday, March 8.

Opening Reception & Show Dates: Join us for the opening reception on Friday, April 5 from 6-8pm at Dare Arts. The show will remain open for viewing during normal gallery hours from April 6 to April 27.

Donated Artworks: Each artist may donate as many finished shakes as they would like. There are no restrictions on medium, orientation, or subject matter. Please note that all works are considered a donation and there is no entry fee to participate.
